

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC INQUIRY**

### **Commons Act 2006 – Section 15**

#### **Application to register Egerton Rothesay School Playing Field in Berkhamsted, Hertfordshire as a Town or Village Green**

Peter Millman, an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State, will attend at Berkhamsted Civic Centre, 161 High Street, Berkhamsted, Hertfordshire HP4 3HB on 25 March 2014 to hold an inquiry into an application by Save Your Berkhamsted Residents Association to register Egerton Rothesay School Playing Field, Durrants Lane, Berkhamsted, Herts HP4 3UJ as a town or village green.

The application was duly made to Hertfordshire County Council and has been referred to The Planning Inspectorate for determination under section 27 of the Commons Registration (England) (Regulations) 2008.

The inquiry will begin at 10.00am on 25 March 2014 and will continue as necessary the next day. Anyone can attend the inquiry. Anyone who wants to be heard on the subject matter of the application may, at the discretion of the inspector, give evidence at the inquiry or arrange for someone to do so on their behalf.
