ADVANCE NOTIFICATION OF CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING WORKS

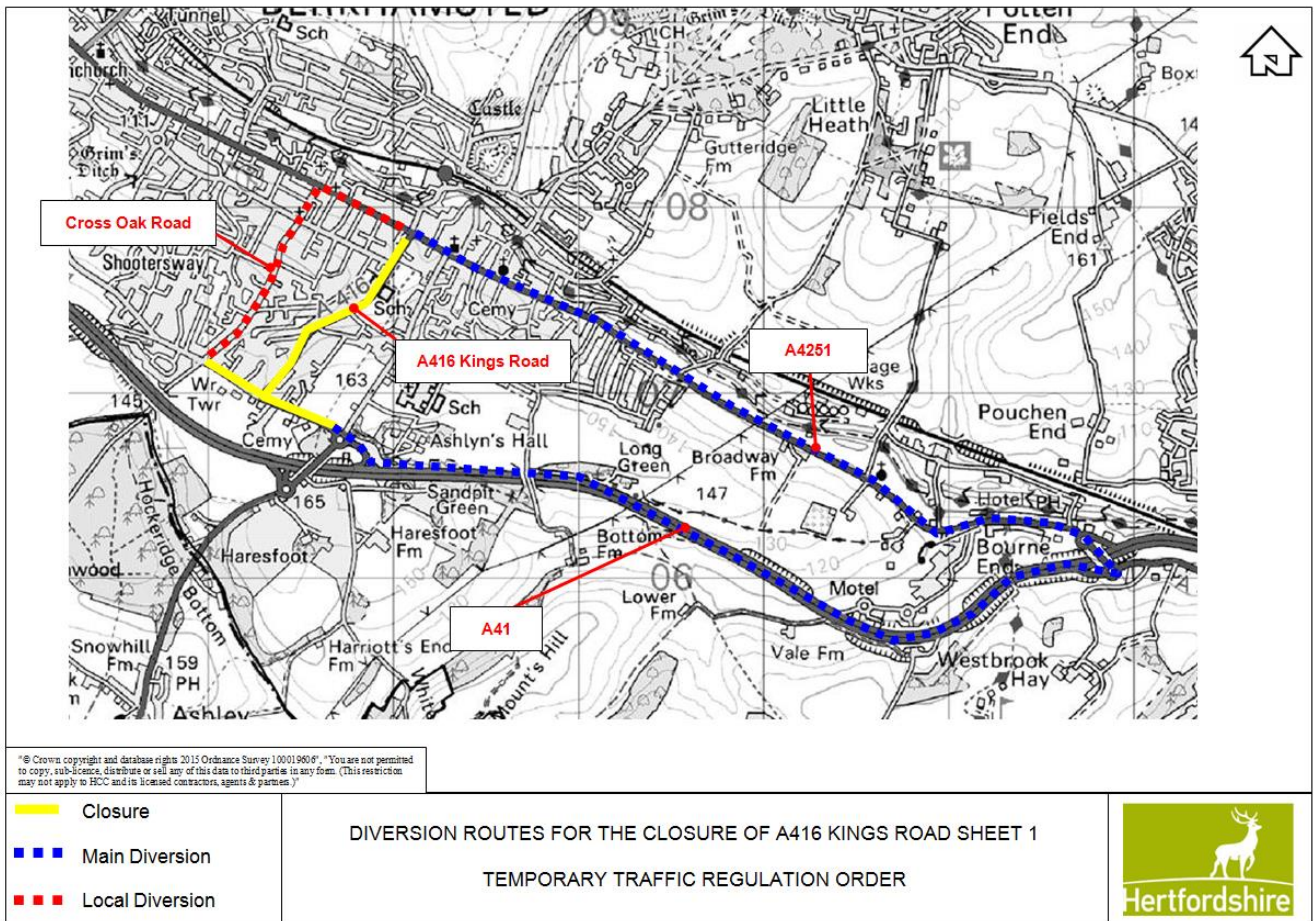
Carriageway resurfacing works are due to commence on the A416 Kings Road, Berkhamsted. The works will be carried out between the junction at Ashlyns Road and the junction at the High Street; the works also include a small section of the High Street. In order to create a safe working environment for the workforce and members of the public alike, the works will be completed using a full road closure, with a fully signed diversion route. See details below for working times. The works are due to start on Monday the 17th of July 2017 and are programmed to take approximately 7 nights to complete (excluding weekends), weather permitting.

All noisy operations i.e. jack hammering and milling out of the old road surface will be completed by midnight. However, if we encounter unforeseen circumstances on site, it is possible we may work outside these hours.

These works form part of Hertfordshire County Councils on-going commitment to maintain and improve the road network in Hertfordshire. We will be replacing the existing worn out road, replacing damaged iron work covers, reinstalling road markings, reconstructing the footway, reinstating the signal loops and cleaning gullies within the newly resurfaced area.

The diversion route during this closure will be:
 All traffic to follow diversion route via A4251 London Road and A41 or vice versa.



Vehicular access to properties during the working hours will be maintained and controlled by gate-person(s) at each end of the closure but there may be delays.

Please do not park in the works area during the publicised dates and times. If parked vehicles are holding up the works and we cannot contact the owner, we will move and relocate them to a nearby street.

Some degree of disruption and delay can be expected as a result of these works and whilst we will make every effort to minimise these please allow extra time for any journeys you may make while these works are in progress. We greatly appreciate your patience and co-operation.

Herts County Council or their Contractors will not approach you offering to carry out works to your property. Any cold calling of this nature by people claiming to represent Herts County Council should be viewed with suspicion, and caution. They will not have Herts County Council authority or approval.
