

**CALL FOR EVIDENCE – FOOTPATH APPLICATION AT CHESHAM ROAD PLAYING FIELD,
BERKHAMSTED
CLOSING DATE 2ND AUGUST 2019**

Herts County Council's Rights of Way Service have received an appeal from the applicants against the Council's decision not to record a footpath running across the playing fields between Upper Ashlyns Road and Chesham Road, on the south side of Berkhamsted.

The applicant has exercised their public right to appeal and has written to the Secretary of State to appeal the Council's decision.

At the Town Planning Meeting to be held on the 15 July 2019, the Committee will agree a letter from the Town Council to the Secretary of State regarding the decision.

Anyone can submit evidence relevant to the appeal decision and the deadline to do so is the **2nd August 2019**.
