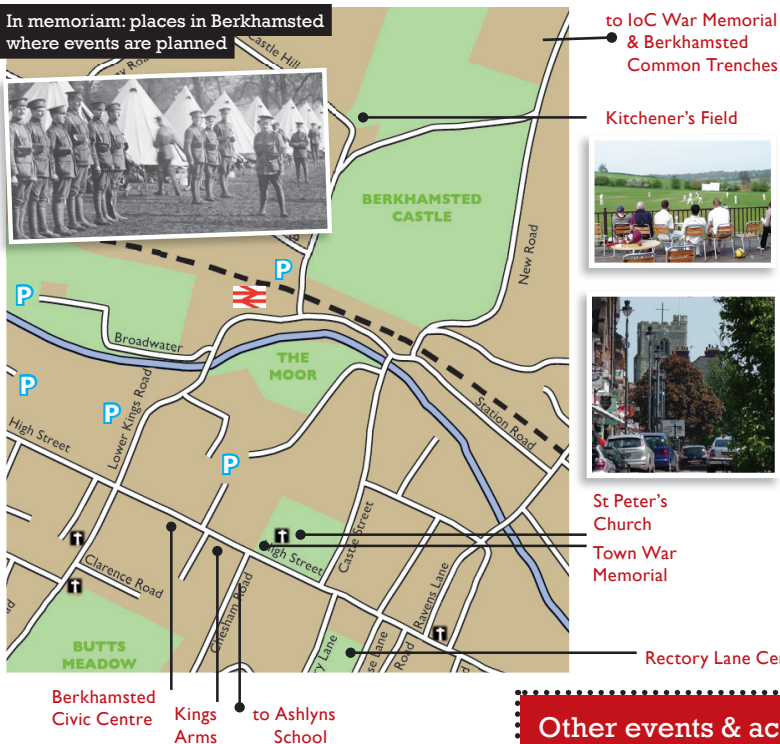
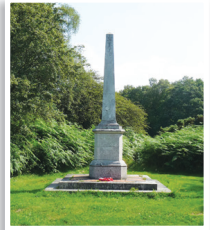

Sunday 3 August

Royal British Legion Parade & Service

2.45pm. To the Town Memorial. Special service of remembrance in St Peter's Church. The Memorial is being repaired and restored by Berkhamsted Town Council.

Monday 4 August

War was declared 100yrs ago at 11pm. Flags will fly at half-mast from public buildings across the country. Poppies will be flowering around the town.

2. Restoration of the town War Memorial
3. Repair of Civic Centre flagpole and flag
4. New audio trail featuring the trenches
5. Ashridge House tours including WWI photos
6. Printing and sale of digital version of IoC wartime magazine *Devil's Own Time*
7. Book and exhibition of Berkhamsted during WWI
8. Trail through WWI graves at Rectory Lane
9. Discovering the stories behind the names on the town War Memorial
10. St Peter's Church to include those named on the War Memorial in their prayers on the nearest Sunday to the anniversary of the individual's death
11. A film with a WWI theme at the Rex (tbc)
12. Poppy seeds to be scattered in the town
13. Three Counties Radio commemorative programme in Nov
14. Berkhamsted Sinfonia memorial concert at St Peter's Church on 15 Nov
15. Local shops to arrange window displays
16. *Devil's Own & the Trenches on the Common* talks on 12 Jun (Court House) and 12 Nov (Town Hall)
