**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES ON VARIOUS ROADS IN
BERKHAMSTED DURING THE 'TOUR OF HERTFORDSHIRE - CASTLE REVOLUTIONS
FESTIVAL'**

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intend to make an Order under Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

1. To prohibit all traffic from using the following lengths of roads and to prohibit all vehicles from waiting, loading and unloading on both sides of these lengths or roads whilst the event takes place:-
 - a) that length of Brownlow Road, Berkhamsted from its junction with Whitehill north eastwards to its junction with New Road, a distance of approximately 513 metres.
 - b) that length of Whitehill, Berkhamsted from its junction with Brownlow Road south eastwards to its junction with New Road, a distance of approximately 219 metres.
 - c) that length of Bridgewater Road, Berkhamsted from its junction with Brownlow Road north westwards to its junction with Billet Lane, a distance of approximately 1170 metres.
 - d) that length of New Road, Berkhamsted from its junction with Whitehill eastwards and north eastwards to its junction with The Common, a distance of approximately 1660 metres.

The temporary traffic management measures will be in place between the hours of 3.00pm on Saturday 9 July 2016 and 9.00pm on Sunday 10 July 2016, when signs are in place. An alternative signed route will be provided for traffic whilst the road closures are in place.

The purpose of the Order is to ensure public safety and prevent accidents for the duration of the 'Tour of Hertfordshire - Castle Revolutions Festival'.
