



COMMUNITY POLYTUNNEL

Proposal

Sunnyside Rural Trust would like to convert our current plots on C12-C14 on Sunnyside Old Allotments into a community polytunnel to support local food growing.

The area is currently made up of some raised beds and used for propagation. The plot is in excellent condition, already sectioned off by native hedges, receives lots of good natural light and has a gentle slope, it is close to a water tank but we would prefer to use rainwater for irrigation, it does require some top soil/ manure to provide suitable growing conditions.

Sunnyside would like to support Sunnyside Allotments to manage their waiting list, support the local community to get involved with food growing, offer some advice to those new to food growing and support people with their wellbeing through horticultural therapy.

We are seeking funds of £3,400 to cover the costs outlined below. Sunnyside will invest labour, materials and growing expertise for the project as match funding.

Project costs

- £1,860.80 for the 45ft by 14ft polytunnel including Vat.
- Guttering and labour for the rainwater harvesting - £225 inc VAT.
- Tools shed - £199 inc VAT.
- Hand tools x6, forks x 2, rakes x 2, secateurs x6 for community growers £200 inc VAT.
- Individual gloves for 12 people £36

- Top soil/ manure layer - £480
- Labour to install polytunnels - free of charge from Sunnyside Rural Trust
- Labour to prepare the area for growing – free of charge from Sunnyside Rural Trust
- 1 ton bags of shingle for drainage for £89
- 25 metres mypex – free of charge from Sunnyside Rural Trust
- Two large water butts – free of charge as we can relocate them from our Hemel site.
- Seeds and plugs for the first year - free of charge from Sunnyside Rural Trust

The polytunnels would belong to Sunnyside Rural Trust and will be entered on our asset register. We will endeavour to maintain the polytunnel and fund any repairs as necessary and affordable. It will be insured under our current policy against theft but not damage.

Sunnyside Rural Trust will work in partnership with Berkhamsted Town Council, Sunnyside Allotments, The Way Inn, Sunnyside Church, Herts Help, Community Action Dacorum, Swan Youth Centre and Age UK to identify those who would most benefit from the resource.

SRT will produce an annual report to BTC, Town Clerk with the number of beneficiaries, demographic data, outcomes and other relevant information.
