(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016**

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce waiting restrictions in Berkhamsted as specified in the Schedules to this Notice. The Order will come into effect on Monday 10 April 2017.

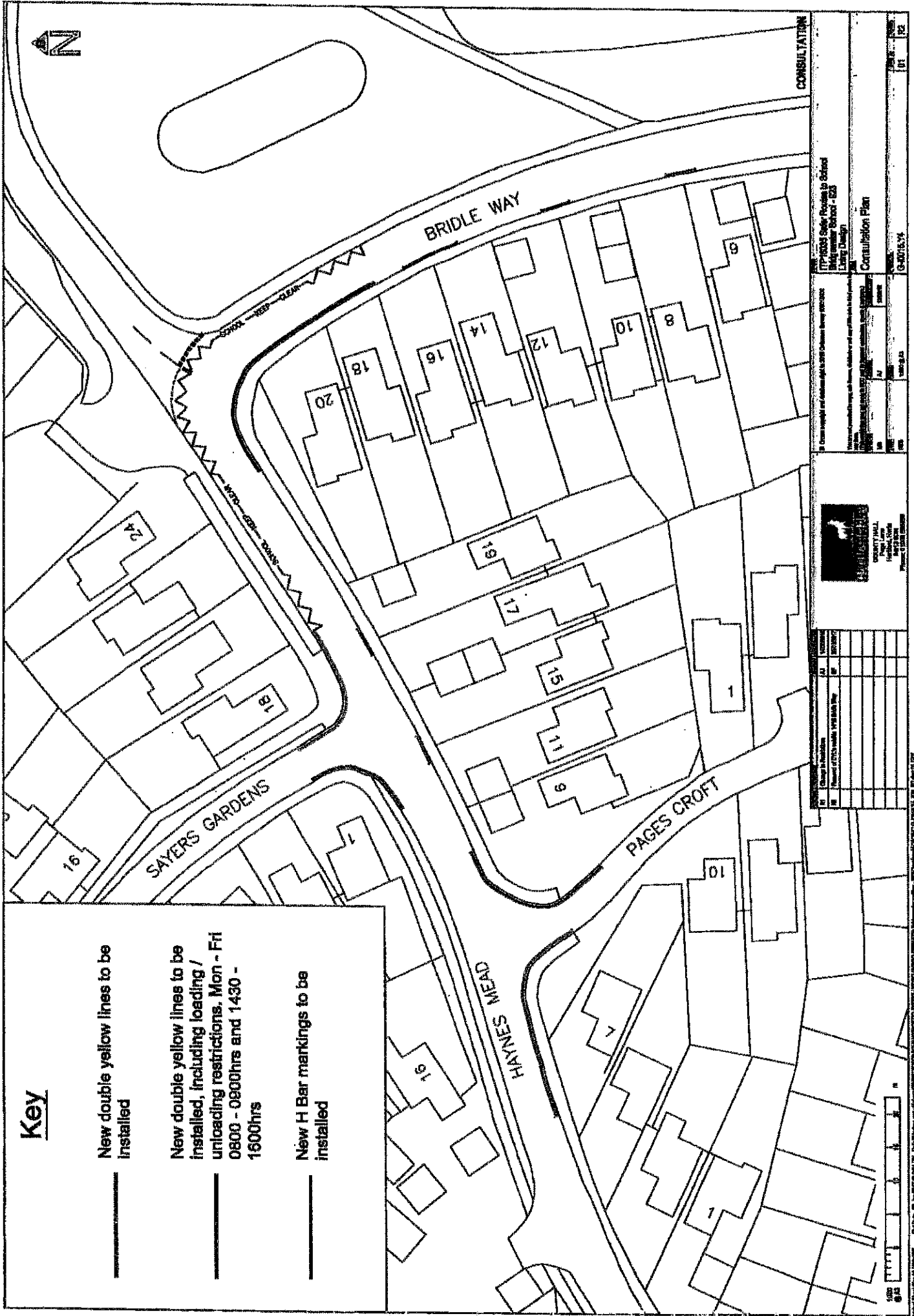
Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

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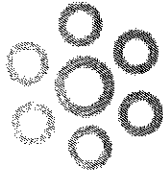

CONSULTATION ON STRATEGIC ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (SEA) / SUSTAINABILITY APPRAISAL (SA) DRAFT SCOPING REPORT FOR NEW LOCAL PLAN

As you may already be aware, Dacorum Borough Council is in the early stages of preparing a new Local Plan for its area. This plan will eventually supersede the adopted Core Strategy (2013), the Site Allocations document that is scheduled for adoption this summer and 'saved' policies from the Dacorum Borough Local Plan (2004).

The purpose of this letter is to invite your views and opinions on a Scoping Report which sets the framework for the future Strategic Environmental Appraisal (SEA) and Sustainability Appraisal (SA) of this new Local Plan. The SA/SEA process seeks to ensure that the Council takes account of all appropriate social, economic and environmental considerations when drawing up its new development strategy, which looks ahead to 2036.

This consultation on the draft Scoping Report is being carried out in accordance with the SEA Directive and the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004. The report is available to view or download on our website:

Whilst we are interested in any feedback you might like to give, we are especially interested in your answers to the following questions:

1. Do you think the Local Plan might have a 'likely significant effect' on Natura 2000 sites (in particular the Chilterns Beechwoods SAC)? If so, in which broad locations and what might be the likely effects?
2. Are there any other policies, plans or programmes (PPPs) that contain environmental protection or sustainability objectives, or which identify issues, that are not covered by the PPPs listed in this Scoping Report?
3. Is there any other baseline information which is relevant to the SA/SEA of the Local Plan that has not been included?
4. Are there any other problems, opportunities or issues that might be relevant to the Local Plan and have not been covered?
5. Are there any further interrelationships between topics that have not been identified?
6. Where do you see the main issues in the area and which topics do you want see addressed with priority within the SA/SEA?
7. Do the SA/SEA objectives provide a reasonable framework through which the likely significant environmental and sustainability effects of the Local Plan can be assessed?
8. Do you believe that the significant effects of the Local Plan can be identified using the methodology outlined in the Scoping Report?
9. Are there other/additional methodologies that could be used to identify the significant effects of the Local Plan?
