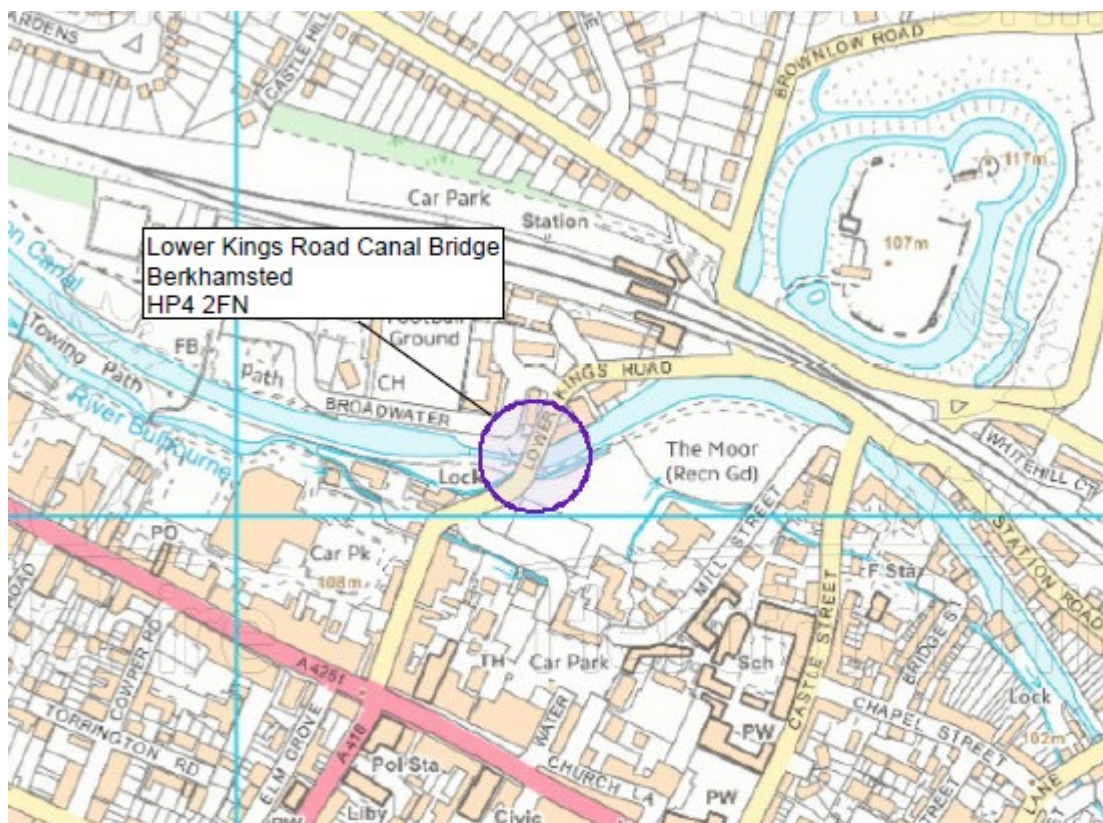


Essential maintenance works will commence on Lower Kings Road Canal Bridge from October 26th 2020 for a period of 5 months. Lower Kings Road Canal bridge is over 100 years old and in need of significant repairs and maintenance to many of its elements. These will include re-construction of the pilasters, installation of a new waterproofing system, full refurbishment of the carriageway and footway, new painting system to the steelwork and other maintenance works. All works will be done in discussion and collaboration with Berkhamsted Citizens Group, Canals and River Trust, Dacorum Council and HCC, to ensure the heritage and look of the bridge is maintained and enhanced for many years to come.



To minimise the disruption to this busy road and to carry out these works safely we will require various traffic management arrangements on the Lower Kings Road and associated towpath. Full programme of these dates is shown in the table below.
